



Mobile Device Policy

Session 2021/22

Personal Mobile Devices (phones etc.)

- These should not be taken out or used in classrooms at any time throughout the school day.
- **Senior Pupils only (S4 to S6)** may use their phones at break or lunch time, outside of the school building.
- Reminder, it is **against the law** to take / share videos of other pupils or teachers in school or near school buildings. If pupils see this happening, we trust that the pupils take responsibility and report this to Mr Chalmet or Mr Caddell as soon as possible.
- When going to the toilet, if you have your phone in school with you, you should leave your phone on the teacher's desk and not take it with you.
- Mobile devices should not be used in the corridors by any pupils (S1-6) when moving between classes.

Headphones

- Headphones can be worn by **Senior Pupils (S4-6)** during **study periods only** when taking part in virtual calls or if music helps S4-6 pupils to focus during independent learning when in these classes.
- In some cases, permission will be granted allowing pupils to use headphones in other classes for specific learning purposes by Mr Chalmet, Mr Caddell, Mrs Bulmer or Mrs Leonard. Permission will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.
- Headphones should not be worn in any other class unless teachers have given permission to use them as part of a specific lesson e.g. watching clips etc. This does not include listening to music or for non-learning activities.
- Headphones should not be worn in the corridors by any pupils (S1-6) when moving between classes.

This policy will be reviewed in August 2022 in collaboration with School Captains.
